## The Accountability Context

- Expanding operational complexity

The Ofsted Education Inspection Framework highlights the importance of:

- Staff wellbeing and workload
- Leadership effectiveness
- Quality of education
- Strong governance oversight

Resilience by Design supports these priorities through proactive system-level design rather than reactive wellbeing initiatives.
